Harmful Algal Blooms are created by cyanobacteria which can produce harmful toxins. Keep this card in your wallet to be ready to ID a HAB to keep you, your family, and your pets safe.

Signs of HAB Poisoning:

Humans: rashes, blisters and hives, and eye and nose irritations. If swallowed can cause diarrhea, vomiting, abdominal pain, numbness of lips, tingling in fingers and toes, dizziness, and headache.

Pets/Livestock/Wildlife:

staggering, difficulty breathing, weakness, salivation, vomiting, and convulsions.
