Vocabulary

- 1. Breakwater A rock pile placed offshore in order to mitigate wave action.
- 2. **Erosion** The geologic process wherein earthen materials (soil, rock, etc.) are worn away and transported by natural forces such as wind or water.
- 3. **Glacial Erratic** Glacially-deposited rock differing from the size and type of rock native to the area in which it rests.
- 4. **Groin** A man-made anti erosion structure constructed perpendicular to direction of longshore drift.
- 5. **Longshore Drift** The transportation of sediment along a coast parallel to the shoreline due to incoming wave direction.
- 6. **Mitigation** The action of reducing the severity, seriousness, or painfulness of something.
- 7. Sediment A solid material that is moved and deposited in a new location.
- 8. **Tombolo** A sandspit that forms reaching for the midpoint of a breakwater. When fully formed can function as a groin.
- 9. Unconsolidated Loosely arranged, not stratified.
